Camping Facilities Are Open

It's called the Lost Lake Scout Reservation, and for years to come it will mean fun, camping, outdoor activities and good times for boys in the Clinton Valley Council of the Boy Scouts of America.

Lost Lake actually is the Council's answer to future year-around camping needs. It's brand new and still a long way from full development.

The 2,880-acre reservation is just west of Clare and within three hours' or so driving time from Oakland and Macomb counties. Purchase of the property, which has three lakes and plenty of area for activities, was made possible by a \$550,000 campaign now nearing completion.

Many units have camped at Lost Lake the last two years. New equipment includes a dock, two boats, six canoes, fire protection equipment and troop campsite facilities. A fulltime ranger manages the reservation.

If you're near Clare stop by. Lost Lake Scout Reservation is the name.
