

Churches Plan Community Services To Give Thanks

Worshippers of The Observer area will unite in at least two community Thanksgiving services this year.

Besides evening community devotions in Farmington and Plymouth, there will be services both tonight and Thanksgiving morning in many churches throughout the area.

FATHER CHARLES MELVIN GUILFOYLE, Passionist Father who preached a retreat to the men of St. Robert Bellarmine's last year, will head a weekend retreat for the Ladies Altar Society.

Father Guilfoyle C.P. is a member of the Passionist Father's Monastery at Norwood Park, Chicago. During the 28 years of his priesthood, Father Guilfoyle has preached 702 retreats, missions and days of recollection. At the moment, he is concluding a series of retreats for the priests of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee.

FORMERLY FATHER Guilfoyle was assistant spiritual director and professor of modern languages and Gregorian chant at the Passionist Father's Seminary outside of St. Louis. He was founder, organizer, and first director of the Laymen's Retreats at Holy Cross Monastery, Mount Adams, Cincinnati.

Recently, he has been selected to be spiritual guide to a Caribbean cruise on the Canadian Pacific Lines flagship, the S.S. Empress, sailing out of New York Jan. 18.

The priest also is well known as a youth counselor.

FATHER GUILFOYLE was born in Chicago Aug. 14, 1912. He received the Passionist habit July 29, 1930 and took first vows July 30, 1931. He was ordained to the priesthood on June 3, 1939.
