Yule Concert Set For Christ Church
Music lovers should circle Sunday, Dec. 10, on their calendars.

Set Production Of Menotti's 'Amahl'
The music department of Farmington will present performances of "Amahl and the Night Visitors" on Sunday and Monday, Dec. 10 and 11. This, the first opera ever commissioned for television, was premiered Christmas Eve 1951, conducted by the composer, Gian-Carlo Menotti.
John W. Cross will produce the drama.
It is the story of the Three Wise Men, on their way to Bethlehem, who seek shelter for a night at the hut of a crippled boy, Amahl, and his widowed mother.
Even though "Amahl and the Night Visitors" is reproduced each Christmas season on television, Menotti believes that since his opera is "impulsive and warm-hearted" it must be seen and "experienced" as a theatrical performance in order to fully enjoy its drama and mystery.
