## Episcopalians Drop Holy Spirit Controversy

The Holy Spirit "procession" from the Father and the Son." The Holy Spirit is "the giver of life, proceeding from the Father."

Nine hundred years ago, that difference of words was part of the controversy that led to a split between eastern and western Christians. Last month, the difference was resolved—at least so far as American Episcopalians are concerned.

A MODERNIZED worship service drops the words "and the Son." A committee which drafted the new text explained why succinctly: "It is simply a recognition of the fact that in (the three) was not originally in the creed, and is therefore not truly ecumenical."

The new service drops centuries of precedent in the Book of Common Prayer and predates the English translation of the Catholic mass now in use in the United States and other English-speaking nations.

AFTER LONG discussion, the authors of the Episcopal liturgy note in their explanation of the service, they decided to retain "Thou" "Thee" and the archaic verb forms that accompany those pronouns in sentences addressed to God.

Otherwise the service is "you" throughout, and the complex sentences the Elizabethans loved have been broken down into the simple declarative sentences endorsed by modern stylists.

THE EPISCOPAL Church is making a determined effort to ensure that the proposed liturgy gets a thorough trial during the three years it is authorized for use and that laymen have ample opportunity to offer considered criticism of it.

Bishop William F. Creighton of Washington circulated guidelines to his clergy this week that stressed his expectation the service would be widely tested in congregations of the diocese.

"The proposed liturgy," he noted, "should not be used casually but continuously for a period of months on a regular basis so that the people can become thoroughly familiar with it."

The bishop also recommended that in testing the rite Episcopalians abandon their penchant for kneeling and try standing, even during such solemn moments as the prayer of consecration and the reception of holy communion.

He also proposed that certain Latin service books, which Christians had previously disagreed with Eastern Orthodox Christians in the status of the Holy Spirit as related above in the quotation from the Nicene Creed.

preparations which customarily have celebrated holy communion at their main Sunday service only once a month consider using the trial liturgy every Sunday during the period they test it.
