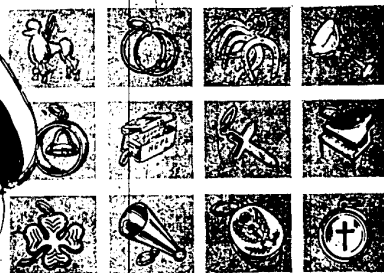

GOP Plays Santa For Inner City

Republican congressmen, legislators, and party leaders of the state of Michigan are going to play Santa Claus for needy inner city children this holiday season.

Dressed in traditional red suits and donning beards, they will board vans loaned by Detroit automotive industries to deliver Christmas parcels to Day Care Centers and to 700 children in serious need. "Happiest Day" will be Thursday, Dec. 21.

Practical gifts such as warm sweaters, underwear and socks as well as a small toy will be distributed to the three to five year olds selected through the local Economic Opportunity Program.

C'ville To Use Auditorium

The Clarenceville Public Schools' music department will present the first annual holiday concert on Wednesday, Dec. 20, 1967 at 7:30 p.m. in the new Louis E. Schmidt Auditorium at the Clarenceville High School.

This will be the first event to be held in Clarenceville's beautiful, new auditorium. It was named after the former, long-time school superintendent, now a member of the Michigan Legislature.

ALL LEVELS of the music department, both vocal and instrumental, from elementary to senior high school, will participate in this program as approximately 450 young people will perform.

Mrs. Marge England and Miss Geraldine Ricker will direct the elementary vocal presentation. Wilbur England, the elementary band; Ted Matlins, the junior high band; Miss Carol Hornung, the junior and senior high vocal groups; and John Nestel, Clarenceville's award-winning high school band.

ALL SEATS for the first annual holiday concert are reserved with an admission fee of 50 cents for both adults and children (students). Tickets may be purchased in advance from any of the music instructors involved. If seats are still available at the time of the performance, the remaining tickets will be sold at the door.

While this is the first event to be held in the Louis E. Schmidt Auditorium, the formal dedication ceremony is not scheduled to take place until after the first of the year.

Order Of Arrow Annual Meet Set Dec. 28

Joe Davis, national camping director of Philmont Scout Ranch, will be the featured speaker at the 1967 annual Order of the Arrow banquet on Thursday, Dec. 28.

The meeting will take place at the Rema Hall, 27777 Schoolcraft, Livonia, beginning at 6:30 p.m.

Davis, a member of the national council executive staff, is camping director of the 137,000-acre Scout ranch which is located in the mile-high rugged Sangre de Cristo mountain country of northern New Mexico. Hundreds of Detroit area Explorers and older Scouts travel to Philmont each summer to take part in back-packing expeditions in the mountains. The annual meeting is being hosted by the Sunset District Chapter of the Order of the Arrow. Hundreds of Scouts and leaders, members of the Michigan Scout Council, will attend the annual affair to elect officers and award outstanding distinctions on their fellow members.

The Order of the Arrow is a National Honorary Camping Society to which Scouts and leaders are elected by their fellow members on the basis of being an outstanding camper and Scout or Scouter. It is a service organization which provides the local council with service at the council camps, and in the promotion of summer camping for all Scouts. Reservations for the 1967 annual meeting will be closed on Friday, Dec. 15, at the Detroit Area Council Service Center immediately.
