Lively Christmas Week Scheduled At Art Institute

Christmas vacation week will be a gala one in the Detroit Institute of Arts auditorium when the Pixie Judy Troupe arrives for a five-day appearance. The company of 11 performers unpacks its trunks to give two performances daily Tuesday, Dec. 26, through Saturday, Dec. 30, sponsored by the museum's Theatre Arts Department.

Two lively musical shows are scheduled: "Alice, Through the Looking Glass" on Dec. 26, 28 and 30 and "The Thief of Baghdad" on Dec. 27 and 29.

"Alice" is a charming adaptation of Lewis Carroll's classic story. His heroine travels through a magic mirror to visit a land where no one is ever punished, here she meets the ferocious Jabberwock, Tweedledee and Tweedledum, the Walrus and the Carpenter, the Red Queen and the White Queen—and a singing Plum Pudding!

"The Thief of Baghdad" steals a magic bottle and uncovers a genie who conveys the orphan hero to exotic Kashmir where one thrilling adventure after another takes place before the "happily every after" ending.

Pixie Judy (Judith Ann Abrams) is the third generation of her family in show business. After working in theatre, radio and television, she is now producer-owner of the Pixie Judy Troupe, the largest repertory musical comedy theatre company for children in the country.

Two special events will take place at each performance: a holiday prize awarded during each show, and Pixie Judy will announce congratulations from the stage to youngsters in the audience celebrating a birthday.
