It was the prosecution's charge that the shooting was deliberately executed as the climax to a series of marital disputes between the pair. They had been married only six months when Mrs. Merilo told him she was going to file for a divorce, Merilo testifted. That occurred at the time of their separation in October, 1966, he said, and he told the jury that after that his wife started seeing another man.

AFTER THE SHOOTING, Merlo escaped from the Creat to Clevaland where he abandoned it. He was arrested in a Philadelphia, Pa. bank two weeks later while attempts to eash an alleged bad check, and disclosed to authorities himself that he was being sought in Michigan.

Philadelphia Detective Alian Rosiond testified at the trial here that Merio had told him of the shooting, laughing because newspapers had called him "the nonchalant killer."
