CIRCUIT COURTS have conducted grand jury investigations since the last amendment to the act, says the brief, No reference is made to the appellate court in the act because no changes have been made in the law since the appeals court was formed.

'The exercise of such original jurisdiction by this court (the Supreme Court) or the court of appeals is expressly prohibited in the constitution itself," adds the brief.


