Lawyer Raps 'For Sale' Sign On Dr. Clark Clinic

A Detroit attorney this week branded the appearance of a 'for sale" sign on the Farm-ington Township medical clinic occupied by Dr. Ronald E. Clark as "completely unauthorized," He immediately demanded its removal.

The attorney, Abel J. Selburn, who represents the estate of the property's deceased owner, Mrs. Hannah Bowerbank, expressed amazement when informed that on the front of the building at 30735 Grand fiver there appeared over the weekend a sign which reads:

"For Sale, Write: Dr. R.E. Clark,"

The administrator of the es-tate, William H. Winsper, of Magshall, Mich., who is Mrs. Bowerbank's brother, confirm-ed that he had not authorized the for sale sign either.


Dr. Clark occupied the clinic, which is labeled the "Farmington Medical Group," with this arrest Nov. 15 on a charge or maniaugher resulting from the Nov. 3 death of a particular pursue. The prosecution contends the least of Mrs. Grace Neil, 43, of Livonia, was from an overdose of sodium pentchal administered by Dr. Clark.

The physician currently is free under \$15,000 bond.

At one time, Mrs. Bowerbank also worked for Dr. Clark,


