Formation of the Schoolcraft College Winter 1968 Evening Choir has been announced by Wayne Dunlap, chairman of the Humanities Division.

The choir, under the direction of Keith Sturdevant, will be composed of 35 voices selected through individual auditions.

Sturdevant, who is supervisor of vocal music and director of high school and college choirs in Highland Park, said the choir will rehearse on a regular schedule starting this month from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m. Tuesdays at the college.

Painting and photography will join music when the Plymouth Symphony presents its annual "family concert" this Sunday, Jan. 28, at 4 p.m. in Plymouth High School.

High school art teacher Mrs. Jessie Hudson said her beginning and advanced art students have been painting to tapes of the music that will be on Sunday's program—Moussorgsky's "Pictures from an Exhibition" and Gunther Schuller's "Studies on Themes of Paul Klee."

The students' paintings will be on display at the concert. In the symphony program, according to Conductor Wayne Dunlap, will be reproductions of the original paintings which the composers set to music.

These include two Klee paintings and three of the Hartmann paintings which inspired Moussorgsky—"Ballet of the Unhatched Chicks," "Hut on Fowl's Legs" and "Great Gate of Kiev."

Thus, the artistry will run full circle—painters' impressions of musical impressions of other paintings.
