

Newsstand Price Will Rise Feb. 4

Beginning with the Sunday issues of Feb. 4 and the Wednesday issues of Feb. 7, the newsstand price of all Observer newspapers will be increased to 15 cents.

The price increase is necessary, Observer Circulation Director Fred J. Wright explained, because of the continuing rise in the cost of printing and distributing a newspaper.

He emphasized that the increase would apply only to papers sold from newsstands, stores and Observer offices. Rates for carrier subscription plans will remain 40 cents a month.

The new rate will make it possible to supply more papers for newsstands and stores where available copies have sometimes been sold out within a half hour, Wright said.
