4. That the University refuse support for any classified resonable expectation (a) that the research will make a significant contribution to the advancement of knowledge or (b) that it will contribute significantly to enhancing the research will.

Finally, the Research Politices Committee called on the University of Michigan to take the lead in forming a nation-wide university group to "work toward the reduction of federal restrictions on publication and dissemination of the results of university recearch."

The major universities should band together, the committee said, to press for declassification "to the absolute minimum consistent with national security."

It said a ban would deny some staff members "frectom to choose the area of inquiry to which they wish to work." In some fields, it acided, taking part in classified research "its vital to the professional development of the scholar."
