Southern Oakland Girl Scouts. It has always been the job of the volunteers and the professionals of the council to try to make the job of the leader easier and more proficient.

With this in mind a plan was worked out to get help and information to the leaders on a more direct route from the council. All of the Farmington-Novi District will be known as the Farmington-Novi Area under the direction of an area chairman. There will be no separate neighborhoods and no neighborhood chairmen.

In place of troop organizers and consultants there will be a troop service director for each of five or six troops who will be under a field director from the Southern Oakland Girl Scout Council. What this really means is that the leader will only have to contact one person for any information or help that she needs.

ONE OF THE BIG complaints of our leaders has been the need for meetings every month. This will also be changed under the new structure. There will be an area meeting only once or twice a year. Aside from this the leaders will only meet when they feel they have a need for it and in that case smaller meetings under the direction of the Field Service Director will be held.

The first area meeting will be held in Nardin Park Methodist Church, 11 Mile Rd., Farmington, on March 6, at 7:30 p.m. Of course, all of the leaders will be expected to attend. The new area chairman will be elected at this meeting and also an area nominating

committee and delegates to Southern Oakland Girl Scout Council.

Most of the neighborhoods have already had their last meeting under the old structure or are getting ready to have it and much information on the change will be discussed.

The new troop service directors have, hopefully, all been appointed and will be taking a training course in the near future. As I get the names of the new service directors I will pass them on to you, so that you will know whom to call for help in your particular area.

JUST A WORD on the Girl Scout Cookie Sale. Cookies will be delivered between March 6 and March 13. The cookies sell for 50 cents per box and as usual there will be quite an assortment.

The troops will make a bonus of five cents per box on the cookies sold and 22 1/4 cents will go to the Southern Oakland Girl Scout Council to be used for camping facilities and connected expenses at the council.

Trophy Won By Troop 110

Boy Scout Troop 110, sponsored by Our Lady of Sorrows Church, won the Camping Trophy at the Ottawa District Polar Bear Derby held at Proud Lake Jan. 19-21.

Led by Scoutmaster Thomas Mahoney and Senior Patrol Leader Mike Schwartz, the troop won the trophy in competition with 16 Ottawa District troops.

Jerry Begoske, of Farmington, Ottawa District camping chairman, was in charge of the derby, which attracted 31 of the 43 district troops and nearly 1,000 Scouts and Scouters.

In addition to the winter camping experience, the annual Polar Bear Derby featured patrol competition in Scouting skills with 45 patrols and 31 troops participating.

Each patrol pulled a patrol-built Klondike sled over a 12-station course and was scored on such skills as first aid, compass, ice rescue, knots, fire building and trail signs.

The Owl Patrol of Troop 110, led by Scouts Greg Schwartz and Ed Semposki, finished fourth in the patrol competition by scoring 259 points out of a possible 263.

The Eagle Patrol, led by Scout David Letourneau, finished fifth with a score of 258 points.

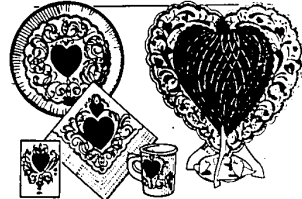
