

Parenthood League To Hear Rowan

Carl T. Rowan, nationally syndicated columnist and former ambassador to Finland, will speak at the annual dinner meeting of the Planned Parenthood League, Inc., in the Mauna Loa Restaurant, at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday, Feb. 13. A Dutch treat cocktail hour will precede the 7:30 dinner.

Rowan, whose column is syndicated through the United States and Canada, is also a political commentator on television and radio. During four and a half years in government service, he was director of the United States Information Agency, ambassador to Finland, deputy assistant secretary of State and a member of the United States Delegation to the United Nations General Assembly.

While serving in the Navy during World War II, Rowan was one of the first Negroes in the nation's history to be raised to officer rank.

Madonna Sets Art Exhibit

Madonna College will present a show of more than 30 paintings by Rosalie Warantus, Feb. 11 through Feb. 18, to be viewed in the Art Department.

The paintings, mostly oils, lean mainly towards the abstract, but in almost all there is recognizable subject matter. The artist earned a BA degree from Alverno College in 1960. She has taught art to over 600 students ranging in ages from first grade through high school. Viewers of this exhibit will find that color and form dominate the paintings. Subject matter only emerges through the form, and color enhances that form. Mrs. Warantus' work appeals to children probably because of its simplicity and color.

The show opens on Sunday, Feb. 11, from 3-5 p.m. It will also be open on Monday, Feb. 12 through Thursday, Feb. 15, from 1-5 p.m. and 7-8:30 p.m. On Friday, Feb. 16, through Sunday, Feb. 18, the show will be open only from 1-4 p.m.
