License Stamps

Some Michigan fishermen haven't been getting what they paid for when they applied for their 1968 licenses, the State Coaservation Department reports.

In apparent confusion over the new license forms, some dealers have only been handing out identification cards to fish-ing license buyers this year. By themselves, the "ID" cards are no more than simple pieces of paper.

· Under the state's revised li censing requirements one or more appropriate stamps must be affixed to the "ID" cards to make them valid for fishing.

An exception involves senior residents 65 years and older who need a separate license for all types of fishing. They are not required to buy stamps for trout fishing.


