# Music Boxes Are On Display

Music boxes from two noted collections are included in "The Wonderful World of Music Boxes" on display in the Industrial Hall of the Detroit Historical Museum until April 21. The exhibit features the Museum's Leonard N. Simons Collection which includes such splendid examples as a Baccarat Decanter incorporating an early cylinder movement, a product of Mermod, Freres and one of Nicole Freres' (c. 1861-65) boxes distributed by Inhof and Mukle of London.

AND THERE will be the rare opportunity of seeing—and hearing—the prize mechanical musical boxes from the noted collection of Mr. and Mrs. Arch L. Rankin of Grosse Pointe. Among the choicest pieces is an early 19th century watch housing a minuscule musical movement that sounds the quarter hours and even plays a little tune each time another 60 minutes elapses.
