As in many of the Pacific Island menus, baked bananas, yams and breadfruit and coconut or sweet potato pudding, are common. Lomi, raw fish pickled with zippy juice of onloan and fruit juices, is often served as an appetizer.

Tropical fruits present a wide gamut of colors, flavors and texturies. Pineapples are, in fact, the sign of friendship. Natives once hung them beather huts as an invitation to enter. Avocados, bananas, oranges, lemons, limes, grabefruit, occounts, dates and figs can be incorporated in meals any time of day.
