

Cranbrook Sets Summer Program

Herbert J. Motley, Jr., head of drama for the Cranbrook schools, has been named director of "Adventure in Creativity," the six-week educational summer arts program to be conducted by Cranbrook School and Kingswood School, Cranbrook, Bloomfield Hills, Peter Kerr, head of the arts department at Cranbrook School, and Eric D. Freudigman, music coordinator for the Cranbrook schools, have been named the associate directors.

The summer program will open June 24 and continue through Aug. 4 with instruction in four major areas: visual arts, music, theater arts and creative writing.

The school, in which all students will be involved to some extent in each of the four departments, is a boarding school accommodating 125 students.

EACH STUDENT will major in one department and minor in a second and all are to participate in evaluative sessions interdepartmentally.

A Harvard graduate, Motley was undergraduate producer of the university theater and president of the Harvard Gilbert and Sullivan Players. Kerr, a graduate of the Tyler School of Fine Arts, until recently headed the Kerr School of Art at Nantucket, Mass.

Freudigman, who is in addition, assistant conductor of the Kenneth Jewell Chorus, earned his B.S. and M.A. de-

grees from Wayne State University. Before coming to Cranbrook he was for five years boys' vocal music teacher at Cooley High School and four years in the same position at Cody High School.

IN THE PROGRAM, students of visual arts are to study basic techniques and theory in sculpture, painting, ceramics, graphics and other areas with each leading toward exhibitions.

Each student of the theater arts has an opportunity to work in the area of his particular skills and interests as well as be exposed to a general overview of all aspects of the theater.
