Open Housing: Constitutional Or Moral Issue?

What was billed as a debate on open housing turned into a dispussion of the unconstitutional points of pending Mitchigan open housing legislation versus the moral responsibility of citizens to favor the issue. The audience, at the Farmington Knights of Columbus so-tial meeting Wednesday evening heard Michigan Sen. George Kuhn (Rep.-14th Dist) outline areas of pending open housing legislation which he felt were in violation of the basic rights of citizens.

At no time did he state he was against open housing itself, merely the means by which it was being brought about. Neither did he speak in favor of any possible legislation in the field which would be suitable to him.

To support his views, Kuhn resented a list of ways in which he felt citizen's constitutional rights would be violated should the present bill under study be passed.

"THE CIVIL RIGHTS Commission could force a person to estify against himself," Kuhn said, "It would be costly to vindicate himself if the complaint were false, yet the false complainer would have the hall use of state facilities and money," in the meantime while a judgment is being debated, sale of the property would be held up for as much as 90 days, he said.

One of Kuhn's prime objections to House Bill 2005 is the power it would give the governor-appointed, not elect-ed, Civil Rights Commission, and these fines are accumulative kuhn said, could be issued without due process of law. Offer Low Mail Rates For Air Packages To GIs

Packages up to 30 pounds for American military personnel served by Army and Flee Post Offices overseas now can be sent by air transportation at special low rates, Livonia Post-master Arthur Jenkins pointed out Monday.

"Area residents using this new airlift service will get much faster delivery on parcels to military personnel overseas," Jenkins said, He said the airlift is available on a space-available basis upon payment of the domestic parcel post surface rate plus a flat \$1 fee.

Packages weighing up to 30 pounds and not more than 60 inches in combined length and girth quality for the new special airliif rates.

POSTAL PATRONS can get the airlift service on packages mailed to all military personnel at APO and FPO addresses overseas, and in Alaska, riawall and Pourto Rico, Jenkins noted that the new airlift also applies to parcels mailed back to the States by servicemen from those military post offices.

Parcels on which the \$I\$ fee

Parcels on which the \$1 fee is paid get air transportation all the way--from here to the port of embarkation, and from there to the overseas base. Postal patrons formerly had to pay air parcel post rates to get similar service.

Jenkins said that in many instances the new airlift rates are considerably below comparable air parcel post charges, He cited these examples:

THE NEW AIRLIPT service went into effect Monday, it was authorized under the postal rate bill signed into law December 16 by President Johnson.

Jenkins explained that the regular postage on parcels malled to servicemen overseas is based on the distance the package is hauded within, the United States, No charge is made for carrying the package to the overseas base.
