Congressional Bill Attacks Cities' Lure To Industry

A congressional bill could make it tougher for Michigan cities to lure new industry through leasing deals.

The bill would remove the federal income tax exemption from bonds which the cities and states might issue in order to build industrial facilities and lease them back to industry. But Michigan officials say the bill has little chance of passage--this year--because Congress is preoccupied with

other tax matters.

LIVONIA IS ONE of the cities which took advantage of a 1965 state law to issue revenue bonds to build a \$33 million processing and distribution plant for Allied Supermarkets, Inc. The plant employs 2,000.

In 1967 three local bond issues were sold totaling \$55.3 million for plants in Michigan cities.

Removing the federal tax exemption could have killed prospective revenue bond deals which are pending in three communities for new plants costing a total of some \$165 million and perhaps employing 1,500 workers, said William J. Cochran, finance specialist in the state Office of Economic Expansion.

The pending bond issues include one for an undisclosed automotive supplier in Southeastern Michigan, which could result in a \$30 million plant employing about 850 persons. The other two potential projects are for proposed paper mills in the Upper Peninsula communities of Escanaba and Munising.

Michigan Still A Highway Leader

Michigan continues as a leader among the states in completion of the national interstate highway system, the State Highway Commission reports. A status report from the U.S. Department of Transportation shows that as of Dec. 31, Michigan ranked eighth in percentage and seventh in miles of interstate open to traffic.

Michigan had opened 837 miles, or 77.4 per cent of its allotted 1,081-mile system. Oregon had 88.4 per cent, Connecticut and Maine, 88.3; New York, 84.9; Wisconsin, 84.3; Kansas, 79.2, and Maryland, 78 per cent. Texas had 1,955 miles, California, 1,351; Ohio, 1,078; New York, 1,039; Pennsylvania, 1,015, and Illinois, 955.

expansion lures totaling half a billion dollars.

Southern states led the list, topped in order, by Alabama, Kentucky, Arkansas, Mississippi, Georgia and Tennessee. Rep. Wilbur D. Mills, chairman of the powerful U.S. House Ways and Means Committee, which would consider the anti-exemption legislation, is opposed to any change and apparently will not find a place for its consideration this year.

The exemption removal has been backed by Rep. John W. Byrnes of Wisconsin, ranking Republican on the Ways and Means Committee, but as long as Mills, the chairman, is opposed the matter probably won't be seriously studied.

Most members of both parties from the Michigan Congressional delegation, though, have at least expressed general support for removing the exemption. Michigan Congressmen and other Northern lawmakers have said the exemption should be replaced or modified, because it works too greatly to the advantage of Southern states, drawing away industry from the North.

Cochran, however, said that from his viewpoint the Michigan act is a "useful tool" in certain circumstances.
