Hatchery Plan Is Unveiled

LANSING—Plans were unveiled to the state Conservation Commission for a \$4.7 million fish hatchery complex on the Platte River, Benzie County, and a satellite rearing station on Manistee County's Little Manistee River. Together they will produce about eight million trout and salmon for planting each year. If funded on schedule, the Platte River hatchery will be geared for planting coho salmon, which will bring first angler returns as adult spawners in 1972. Wayne H. Tody, chief of the Conservation Department's Fish Division, reported that the Platte River plant will be phased into production in three stages. The first calls for \$1.5 million, including up to \$1.2 million of construction work which would be financed 50-50 between state and federal funds.

THE HOUSE AND Senate Joint Capital Outlay Committee of the Michigan Legislature has included in its deficiency appropriation bill an item which would authorize the Conservation Department to carry out this first phase of construction.

Department engineers plan this June to award the opening contract for construction of the site's main hatchery building and installation of a pipeline for water intake from Brundage Pond. They have January 1970 as their target date for completing this work.

The hatchery site, located east of floor, already features a fish weir, outdoor sorting ponds, and a spawn-taking house where the Department collected about 8 million coho eggs last fall.

Phase II of the hatchery development is priced at \$1.9 million and scheduled for completion August 1970, if financed. It will involve the installation of a pumping station, 14 recirculating raceways, and administration and hatchery service buildings.

UNDER THE THIRD and final phase of development on the Platte, work will center on construction of 16 remaining raceways, fish-handling facilities, fish detention ponds, and four residences for supervisory hatchery personnel. Phase III will cost \$1.3 million and hopefully be completed in February 1972.

No timetable has been worked up for the \$1,020,000 Little Manistee rearing station which will annually produce about 125,000 pounds of fish, one-third of the output from the Platte River operation.

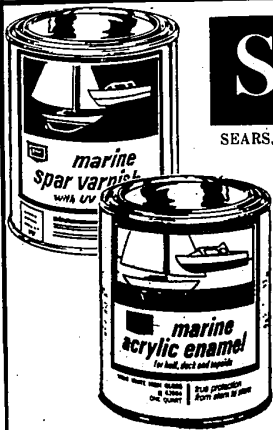
The Little Manistee site already has a fish weir, fish way, spawn-taking house, and water intake structure.
