SOUTH LYON--The Board of Education has approved an increased seating capacity of 1,860 for the new high school gymnasium. Cost of expanding the facility from housing 1,547 people to the present size is estimated at \$4,468. Reason for the action was to allow the school the capacity to host various state-wide sports tournaments.

SOUTHFIELD--The Southfield PTA Council has demanded that the Southfield Board of Education take a stand on the question of aid for students attending non-public schools in the state.

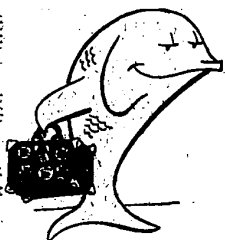
