

McNamara Steps Down, Clifford In Charge

CLARK M. CLIFFORD, reputedly a hardliner on the Vietnam war, took oath of office as the new Secretary of Defense Friday. Chief Justice Earl Warren administered the oath to the 61-year-old Washington lawyer at a White House ceremony. Robert S. McNamara officially stepped down from the position last week.

Change In MSU Rules Approved

A Women's Inter-residence Council of Michigan State University proposal to delete two sentences from the student handbook has been approved by Milton B. Dickerson, vice-president for student affairs. The sentences to be deleted call for overnight sign-out by a coed to a man's apartment unacceptable behavior.

Dickerson said that he hopes that the deletion does not give the impression that "we don't expect student to use standards of conduct. We expect the responsibility of conduct to rest with the student," he said.

The two sentences to be deleted read: "In housing not under the control of the University, students are expected to conduct themselves in keeping with standards acceptable to the University community. Overnight visitation in the living quarters of a member of the opposite sex is not acceptable behavior."

A sample of women's opinions on campus indicated that 66 per cent approved and 34 per cent disapproved of the policy change.
