## Engagements And Weddings

Wedding and engagement pictures submitted for publication in The Observer must be clear prints, not in color, and accompanied by pertinent information typed or clearly printed.

There is a charge of \$2.50 for engagement pictures. Information should include names and addresses of the prospective bride and bridegroom and their parents, and the wedding date. Information on education and employment may also be included.

Wedding pictures are printed for \$2.50 (one-column) or \$5 (two-column). Information should include the names of the bride and bridegroom and their parents, the date, time and place of the wedding, and names of attendants. Brief descriptions of the gowns may be included if desired. In general, only pictures of the bride alone will be printed. Forms for wedding information are available at all Observer offices.

No charge is made for printing engagement and wedding announcements without pictures.

All charges are payable at the time the picture is submitted, and they will be published in the order received and paid. Checks should be made payable to The Observer and pictures may be mailed to 271 S. Main, Plymouth, 48170, or taken to any office of this newspaper.

## Funds For Project HOPE Pass Goal

The Greater Detroit Chapter for Project HOPE surpassed its fund-raising goal in 1967 for the fourth consecutive year by collecting \$307,437.72. Officers said the total represents cash donations only. Additional large gifts of medicine and medical equipment were also received by the Chapter.

The cash total includes donations from many corporations and foundations, as well as gifts from thousands of individual Detroiters. Special credit was also given to the Women's Division of Project HOPE who raised \$46,000 with an Ambassadors Ball in May. The money will be used to support the hospital ship S.S. Hope, which will sail for Ceylon March 6 to begin a 10-month treating and teaching mission. In the seven year history of the S.S. HOPE, 9,000 major operations have been performed, 100,000 people have been treated and over 1 million children have been immunized.

missions from all over the United States, including the White House, for his glass pieces.

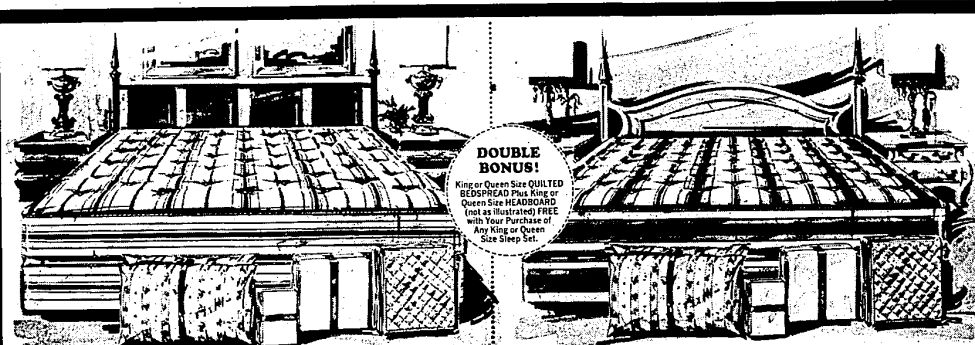
