Architect Selected For New Elementary School

An architect for Farmington's 19th elementary school was chosen by the Farmington Board of Education Monday night.

Named to the post was the Dearborn firm of Jahr-Anderson Associates. The firm has been engaged in school construction work in the past, but this is its first contract with the Farmington districts.

The new school, which is scheduled to open in Sept. 1969, will be located on a site adjacent to the Mercy High School complex at 11 Mile and Middle Belt Rds.

Architectural fee for the firm's services was set at 3.4 per cent of the total cost of the building. This is the established fee for construction work of a size of an elementary school.

No budget has currently been set for the building, but it is expected to be about \$800,000.

IN OTHER ACTION

Board:

Approved plans for a 3894 square foot addition to the Wil-

liam Grace School. At an estimated cost of \$120,000 the new facility will be used as a resource center.

Voted to petition the township on the necessity of water installation to service the Alameda School. The Board's action came after the trustees heard a report from the township that the school district's consent was required to provide the proper percentage of property owners in order to establish the special assessment district.

It is estimated that the total construction for the water line on Alameda between Orchard Lake and Farmington Rd. will be \$25,000. The district's share will be \$3,600 and an additional tap-in charge of an estimated \$1,400 will be required to bring the water into the school.

A factor in the district's decision was the maintenance problems to the heating systems brought about by well water.

GRANTED an easement to the developer of the Williamsburg Apartments on 12 Mile Rd. for drainage purposes through the Dumekel School property to the Minnow Pond drain.

Scheduled the next regular meeting of the Board of Education for Tuesday, March 26.

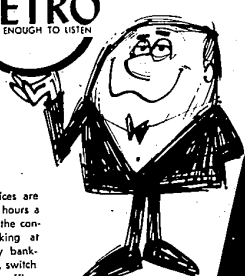
