The plot of the musical, based on Mark Twain's book "Life on the Mississippi," will entertain youngsters and their parents who will be busy recognizing characters from other books by the famous humorist as they wander into the action on stage. The actor portraying Twain doubles as the narrator of the play and also appears in the episodes he introduces.

Mary Rodgers, who composed the specially made-for "Young Mark Twain," is the daughter of Richard Rodgers. She established her own reputation with the score for "Once Upon a Mattress" and has written material for the popular Baird Puppets.

"Young Mark Twain" is another event in the museum's Theatre Arts Department program to introduce school age audiences to a variety of live theatre entertainment. It will be presented at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. on April 6.
