cars, Throughout SeM, 31.5 errors in the bulk of the detailed TALUS data was obtained during the 1985-96 travel survey and included interviews with restinates of every 25th households in an area encompassing 93 percent of the 1.3 million shouseholds in SEM."

The data shows 8,549 people living in the City of Farmington in 24,93 households. This results in a "population per household" figure of 3.4. In Farmington Township, 34,990

the heads of households in the area are college graduates, compared with 11.3 percent of all Detroit region residents," Rubin said.
"The community has a high percentage of households with the youngest child of school age," Rubin said.
In 37 percent of City of Farmington households, the youngest child is from 5 to 17 years of age, The Farmington Township percentage is 30.2. In all of SEM, the comparable figure is 26.8 percent.

IN ADDITION, in Farming-ton Township, in a high per-centage of households—30.1--the youngest child is a pre-schooler, substantially higher than the 23.5 percent of all in SEM. But in Farmington, in on-ly 19.6 percent is the youngest child under five years of age, he said.

"Farmington area house-holds are generally prosperous," Robin said. "The median amount of the properous of the farmington 43,8 percent of the families have incomes between \$10,00 and \$20,000 per year. In Farmington 43,8 percent of the families are in this category. Only 25,3 percent of all the households of SEM are in this income bracket.

"Such 'plus' factors as high-"such 'pius' factors as high-er incomes, above-average educational attainment, a high percentage of school-age youngsters and the great amount of travel activity constitute challenges to Farmington Inef-forts to continue as a thriving, growing community," Rubin said.

Both Farmington (with 64.5 percent) and Farmington Township (with 66.9 percent) have a higher percentage of "white collar" workers as heads of household than the 41.6 percent average for SEM, he said.

A SPECIAL project of the Southeast Michigan Council of Governments, TALUS has completed most of tis fact-gathering and is now beginning to utilize known facts in planning regional growth to the year 1990. "In about two more years, after more than four years of exacting work and the expenditure of about \$4.8 million, TALUS will make specific planning recommendations," Rubin said.

"These recommendations will be guided by the needs and desires of the people of the re-gion as revealed in our survey, and in our continuing contact with county and local officials.
