Book Collector Will Go Public

Earl W. DeLaVergne, 35970 Quakertown Lane, Farmington, will have items from his collection of historical data pertaining to the Great Lakes area included in the Detroit Public Library's "Detroiters Collect" exhibition April 19 through May 18.

Purpose of the exhibit is to honor those whose private libraries extend the resources of public institutions.

According to the library's rare books chief, Gloria Francis, "the astuteness, taste, intelligence and devotion with which the private collector builds his library ultimately benefits the world of scholars."

DeLaVergne's collection reflects all these qualities. His interest in the history of the Great Lakes region began 40 years ago while he was a student at the University of Michigan. Having been born in Harbor Springs, only deepened DeLaVergne's lifelong devotion to this subject.

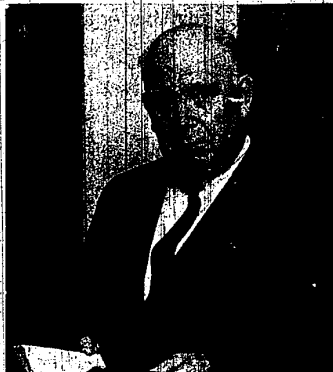
He won't quote a value on his 2,000-some pieces of material, which include books, old Indian prints and maps, but likes to say, "The Wall Street Journal says that one of the best investments you can make is old books."

DeLaVergne rates two books as among his most rare pieces.

They are "The Shanty Boy," a paperback story of lumbering published in Cheboygan in 1889, and "The Bark Covered House," by William Nowlin, an 1876 story of pioneer life around Dearborn.

The collector took no chances when he moved to his home in Farmington, while back. When he was living in Livonia, his street was once flooded; water got into his home and destroyed part of his valuable collection.

He now lives on a ravine lot and has a bookroom on the lower floor. Despite this, his collection had grown so large that he recently had to scale it down to the 2,000 pieces it now contains.
