Hand wash rainer than ha-chine wash. Launder glass fabrics sep-arately, using a mild soap or synthetic detergent, Handle fabrics carefully, Avoid rubbing or twisting articles.

Roll or wipe articles with a
towel. Then spread them out
flat or hang on padded lines
to dry. Do not use a clothes
dryer.

Do not iron glass fabrics.


