# Final Plymouth Concert Sunday Stars Pianist

Pianist Benning Dexter will be guest soloist when the Plymouth Symphony Orchestra presents its final concert of the 1967-68 regular season. The free concert will begin at 4 p.m. Sunday in Plymouth High School, Church at Main streets.

Dexter will be heard with the orchestra in Rachmaninoff's second piano concerto. The orchestra, conducted by Wayne Dunlap, will perform Mozart's overture to "The Marriage of Figaro" and Franz Schubert's seventh symphony. Theme of the concert will be "the heroic summing up," says Conductor Dunlap.

PIANIST DEXTER joined the University of Michigan faculty in 1949 and has been chairman of the piano department in the School of Music since 1961. A native of California, Dexter received his major training in New York during five years of Juilliard Fellowship study under Alexander Siloti, who was the teacher of Rachmaninoff. He has given concerts and recitals in the U.S., Canada and the Orient, and has also made radio and educational television appearances.

While stationed with American occupation forces in Japan following World War II, Dexter had his own radio program and made recordings for Columbia.

MEANWHILE, the Plymouth Symphony Society, which helps

support the orchestra, is conducting its annual membership drive.

A variety of memberships will be solicited from families, businesses and civic organizations.

Patron membership is \$50 and up; sustaining, \$25 supporting, \$15; active, \$10. Donations are amounts less than \$10.
