Residents of Farmington Township were advised this week that the annual spring clean-up in which trucks will canvass the area for miscellaneous rubbish has been scheduled for three Saturdays in May.

Discarded appliances, old furniture and general odds and ends that may have accumulated in garages and basements may be placed at roadsides for pick up.

No garbage will be accepted, nor will any building materials or inflammable items. Trucks of the Taulbee Sanitation Co. will cover the strip of the township between Eight and Nine Mile Rds. on May 4.

This will include residences on the south side of Nine Mile only.

The following Saturday, May 11, all of the area from the north side of Nine Mile through the south side of 11 Mile Rd. will get the same treatment.

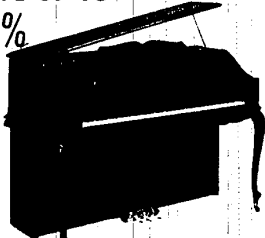
The effort will be completed
