It's Official: Humphrey Has Hat In Ring

WASHINGTON -- Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey announced Saturday he will seek the Democratic nomination for president. His announcement included words of praise for President Johnson and a statement that "without unity we shall begin to doubt not only ourselves but our goals and ideals."

Humphrey said that as a candidate "I shall continue to fulfill, to the best of my abilities, the duties of my office. I shall, as the president has, observe the absolute priority of peace over politics."

COLUMBUS -- Black students backed by anti-war demonstrators ended a four-hour takeover of Ohio State University's administration building Friday after receiving a signed statement from school officials. The statement pledged that the school would investigate complaints that four black girls were ejected from a bus last week for discussing "black student problems."

BEAUMONT, TEX. -- Five members of the Lamar Tech track team died with their coach and a pilot Sunday when their plane returning from the Drake Relays at Des Moines, ebbed and exploded as it came in for a landing. The aircraft plunged into a rice field and burned a mile north of the runway after making a routine request for landing clearance, the Federal Aviation said.

National News Round Up

AUSTIN, TEX. -- Former Alabama Gov. George Wallace claims he will seek repeal of the recently passed federal open housing law and predicted that the Supreme Court would take on a different ideological hue if he is elected president. Wallace was on a three-day whirlwind tour of Texas to gather 14,000 names to get on the presidential ballot there. At one rally he received a standing ovation when he said if he was elected president he would ask the attorney general to jail any college professor or student who called for a Communist victory in Vietnam. Wallace is running on his own third party ticket.

CHEYENNE, WYO. -- Presidential candidate Robert Kennedy welcomed Hubert Humphrey's entry into the Democratic race for presidential nomination and said it would afford the people a choice. Answering various questions on the nation's health problems, he said solutions could include use of nonprofessionals for simple medical care, establishment of neighborhood health centers, eradication of slums and reduction of air pollution.

HOLLYWOOD -- A 25-year-old supermarket manager became enraged when five bandits held up the market while his mother was on duty as a clerk. They took \$1,113. The manager, Guy McIlarty, took three bag boys with him and chased the getaway car in a running gun battle that ended with the capture of four men. McIlarty fired a carbine at the getaway car for five miles during the 80-minute on-hour chase until he punctured one tire, forcing the bandits to stop. Three of the men surrendered and lay face down, hands behind their heads on the busy highway, under the gun of McIlarty. A fourth man was found an hour later by police in a nearby field. The men had held McIlarty's mother captive while they rifled cash registers. The fifth man escaped.

NEW YORK -- According to a Fortune magazine survey, the two richest Americans, the only ones who probably can be called billionaires, are J. Paul Getty and Howard Hughes. Oilman Getty, 75, and financier Hughes, 62, are followed by six others who are half-billionaires and 150 who have a net worth of more than \$100 million. The magazine estimated Getty's visible assets of \$957,404,289 conservatively and \$1,383,417,310 liberally. Hughes' wealth is estimated at \$985,500,000 conservatively and \$1,373,000,000 liberally.
