

Senate Group Subpoenas Detroit News Publisher

LANSING -- State Treasurer Allison Green reported that the new Michigan income tax revenues yield is more than meeting expectations. The personal income tax alone--which went into effect Oct. 1, 1967--has poured slightly more than \$155 million into the Treasury by the end of March. Additional revenue from the income tax is now beginning to come in from the tax on corporations and banks, which went into effect Jan. 1. A \$14,000 trickle was reported from January from the corporate tax.

LANSING -- Gov. George Romney is expected to appoint University of Michigan Regent Robert P. Briggs of Jackson, as state banking commissioner. Briggs would have to resign as regent to accept the banking post. Romney has not formally asked him to take the post. However, leading bankers in the state have convinced Briggs he should take the job, vacated last month by Charles Slay. Briggs retires as Consumers Power Co. vice president May 1, at age 65.

WASHTENAW COUNTY -- Unformed Deputy Sheriff Fred J.

Potill, 20, secretary of the Washtenaw Deputy Association, fired last Dec. 4 by Sheriff Douglas J. Harvey and temporarily restored to duty last month, was suspended last Friday. He was ordered by the Sheriff to appear at 10 a.m. May 9 for a trial board hearing before four members of the department. He will remain suspended from duty until that time. Sheriff Harvey said Potill was suspended for insubordination which stemmed from a dispute

DEARBORN -- The Ford Motor Co. gave Simon E. Knudsen 35,000 shares of stock worth about \$500,000 as an annual salary of no less than \$200,000 to become its president in February, the company's proxy statement showed last week. Knudsen resigned from General Motors where he was an executive vice president, to take over as head of the nation's second largest auto company.

JACKSON -- Walter R. Boris, 46, who has served for the past 12 years as corporate secretary of Consumers Power Co., has been elected vice president for finance, effective May 1 upon retirement of Robert P. Briggs, the company's executive vice president.

ST. JOSEPH -- Berrien County supervisors have reminded steadfast to their convictions against changing to daylight time with the remainder of Lower Michigan last weekend. The supervisors Friday voted 30-16 against a motion to rescind previous action putting the Southwest Lower Michigan county on standard time -- "refusing to push the clock ahead one hour."

DETROIT -- Peter B. Clark, publisher of the Detroit News, sent Gov. George Romney a telegram Tuesday stating he would attend any negotiations set up by Romney. Clark told Romney that he wanted to keep the negotiations between the News and the striking craft unions within the bounds of present restrictions. State Sen. Robert J. 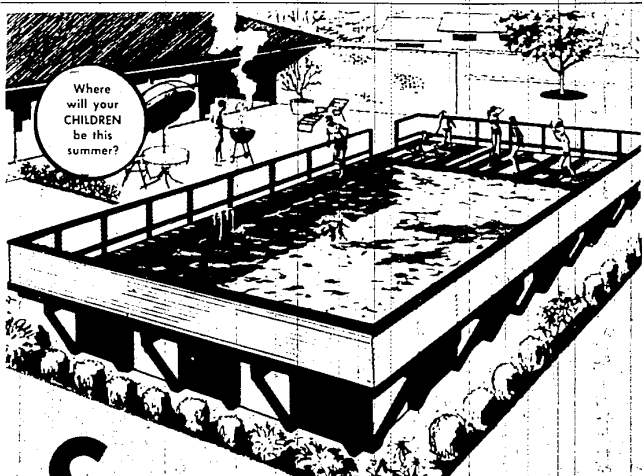
