

Canham Gets Aid For Intramurals

ANN ARBOR -- The Regents of the University of Michigan has approved the establishment of an advisory committee on intramurals, recreation, and club sports.

The new committee will advise the director of physical education and athletics concerning University needs in the development and maintenance of facilities and programs in recreation, club sports, and intramural competition.

THE UNIVERSITY maintains one of the nation's most extensive programs in these areas. In intramural competition alone, there are 38 sports open to student, staff, and faculty participants. Organized clubs also compete in boxing, fencing, judo and Korean self-defense, lacrosse, rugby, soccer, diving, soccer, weight lifting, squash, and tennis.

Membership in the advisory committee will be patterned after that of the Board in Control of Intercollegiate Athletics; the director of physical education and athletics, ex officio, to serve as chairman; four members of the University Senate, to be appointed by President Robben W. Fleming, subject to Regent approval; a representative of the Office of Student Affairs; chairman of the intramural program and departments of physical education for men and for women, ex officio; two undergraduate male students and two undergraduate female students in their fourth term, to be chosen by the student body.

Since the first feasible election for student members is the spring of 1969, President Fleming was authorized to make initial appointments of one pair of students to serve until fall 1969 and a second pair to serve until fall 1970.

ALLAN F. SMITH, the University's vice president for academic affairs, indicated that the advisory group would begin to function soon.

"We hope to get the committee organized as soon as possible so that it can begin its work on developing a program and exploring methods of financing it," he said.

"I expect that Mr. Canham (athletic director-elect Donald B. Canham) will take an active role from the start of the committee's work. I also expect that even though club sports are not directly represented on the committee, it will be possible for the director and the committee to ascertain the interests and needs of that aspect of the University's program so that it will not be overlooked."

He was promoted to auditor of highway contractors' qualifications, in 1961.












