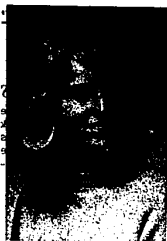


Brides-To-Be Tell Plans

'Mental Health' Topic Of Extension Seminar

Three hundred and fifty women from Wayne and Oakland counties recently attended a Mental Health Seminar held at Wayne State University and sponsored by Michigan State University's Cooperative Extension Service. "The Emotionally Disturbed Child," "Tensions and Pressures in Today's Society," and "Menopause" were the topics explored by three eminent speakers, Dr. Ralph Rabinovitch, director of Hawthorn Center for emotionally disturbed children; Dr. Benjamin Joffries, associate clinical professor of psychiatry at Wayne State University; and Dr. Thomas A. Petty, M.D., Psychiatrist, Grosse Pointe.

DR. RABINOVITCH, who specializes in treatment of children, stressed that treatment is one of the biggest factors in prevention of mental disturbances in youngsters. "Michigan's facilities for treatment need improvements

desperately," he said as he urged a grass roots campaign among his listeners to investigate situations in their communities.

However, Dr. Rabinovitch also stated that continuing research on brain damage in children is permitting afflicted youngsters to lead fuller lives. In addition, research is revealing new methods or preventing brain damage.
