Westland Soldier Honored

A Westland soldier has been
awarded an Air Medal for serv-
ing on 25 helicopter missions
in South Vietnam.

Receiving the award is Army
Sgt. Stephen Miller, 21, son
of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Mil-
ler, of 32032 Sandra Lane.

Miller, who graduated from
Franklin High School in Lit-
vonia, is a crew chief for four
helicopters.

Mrs. Miller also reported
that her son was at an Air
Force base near Saigon when
the Vietcong's jet offensive was
started.

Miller and six others vol-
unteered to guard the perimeter
of the huge base, which is the
site of the headquarters of Gen-
eral William Westmoreland,
commander of American forces
in Vietnam.

He and the others stayed
three and a half days at their
posts during the massive of-
fensive.

Miller enlisted in the Army
two years ago and has been
in Vietnam since last Sep-
tember.

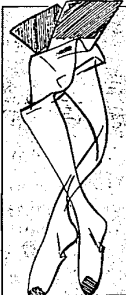

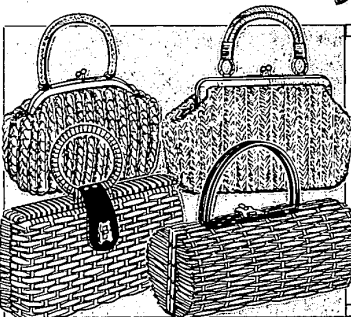

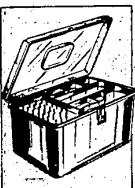
