## Bentley Concert Slated

Members of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra will present two free concerts Friday, May 17, in Livonia's Bentley High School.

James Frazier, Jr. will conduct.

Concert times are 9 a.m. and 10:30 a.m.

The concert will be sponsored by the Music Performance Trust Funds of the Recording Industries in conjunction with the Detroit Federation of Musicians and other private contributions.

Included on the program will be works by Mozart, Webern, Tchaikovsky, Ravel, Puccini, Haydn, Rossini and Beethoven.

Frazier is a 28-year-old native Detroitian. This will be his third conducting appearance with the Symphony. He has also conducted the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic, Danish State Radio and Rome Symphony Orchestras.

## Old-Time Silver On Display

An exhibit of Tuttle sterling silver including Early American and 17th Century English reproductions will be presented through May 11 at Charles W. Warren & Company in Detroit.

Highlight of the exhibit will be the week-long appearance of Walter Camp, a Tuttle Silver-smith, who will spin Paul Revere bowls in the second floor Silver Gallery.

The bowls, which will be sold, are a part of the Tuttle 200th commemorative anniversary of the Paul Revere Sons of Liberty Bowl crafted by the famous patriot in 1768. The historic bowl is now displayed at the Boston Museum of Fine Arts.

Working at a spinning lathe, Camp will craft custom Revere bowls in four through 11 inch widths. Each piece will be hallmarked with the Tuttle Pine Tree Shilling and the crescent bearing the initials of the incumbent President of the United States.

Additionally, six special table arrangements featuring the broad line of Tuttle sterling silver will be presented.

The exhibit will be open to the public during regular store hours.

The Finlandia Male Chorus will present its annual Spring Concert Saturday, May 11, in the Southfield High School Auditorium. Concert time is 8 p.m. The school is located at 10 Mile and Lahser Rd.

Featured on the program will be the 40-voice male chorus, with solos and featuring a mandolin string group.

Guest soloist will include Emily Waymyren, at 11th grade at Dearborn's Lowrey High School, and John Trowbridge, a senior at Redford High. Trowbridge placed first in the 1967 Livonia Youth Symphony competition.

Eero Keranen, a resident of Livonia, is director of the chorus, while Carol Joupitt is the accompanist.

Tickets are available from any chorus members and will be sold at the door. Admission price is \$1.50 for adults, with children under 12 admitted free.

## WSU Slates 'Royal Hunt'

Peter Shaffer's theatrical drama of the Spanish conquest of Peru, "The Royal Hunt of the Sun," will open at Wayne State University's Bonstelle Theatre at 8:30 p.m. Friday, May 17 and run for six performances.

This will be the last play of the current Bonstelle season.

An historical drama based on the 16th Century conquest of the Inca Indians by the Conquistadors, the play is a colorful and dramatic spectacle of music, dance and classic warfare.

At the heart of the conflict are the aging leader of the Conquistadors, Francisco Pizarro, and the young Inca ruler Atahualpa, who believes that he is immortal.

"THE ROYAL Hunt of the Sun" was first performed at Britain's National Theatre in 1964. There it won the acclaim of London critic Bernard Levin as "the greatest play of our generation." In 1965 it moved to New York where it played with great success.

Playing the role of Pizarro in the Bonstelle production will be Martin Molson, a former member of the Hillyer Classic Theatre Company.

Later performances are scheduled Saturday night, May 18, and Thursday through Sunday, May 23-25. All performances will begin at 8:30 p.m., except the Sunday matinee which will begin at 2:30 p.m.
