"Bluegilis, suntish and perch that are only a few inches long may already be full grown," says Eugene Roelots, professor of tisheries and wildlife at MSU. "Oftentimes our small lakes in Michigan are so overcrowded with these pandish that they never grow large enough to keep "fishermen always keep the large bass," he says, "andtoss back the small panifsh, but this just makes things worse,"

"Not true," says Roelofs.

"The over-populated small sunfish or perch compete with the young bass for food, and sooner or later start feeding on the newly hatched bass, Then the lake turns into a big bowl of stunded sunfish.

"So, it is better to keep all the sunfish, bluegilis or perch that you catch from a small lake or pond, As cat food or rose bed fertilizer these little fish are excellent, but put back into ponds they'll undoubtedly die of old age and still be three laches long!"
