Take Prizes

Ceramic artworks by Farmington's John Parker Glick are going far afield from the potter's studio, Plum Tree Pottery, 30435 10 Mile Rd.

The potter is currently represented in two exhibitions, the Great Fall River Art Association's annual, national show, Fall River, Mass., and the Distinguished Alumni Exhibition at Wayne State University.

A set of wine goblets designed and executed by Glick took first prize in ceramics in the Fall River showing and also took a first in the recent Mississippi Arts Festival.

Work by Glick can be seen in many public and private collections, including those of the Detroit Institute of Arts, Kramert Art Museum, University of Michigan, South Bend Art Association and Ceramics Magazine.

'Young Abe' Takes Stage

The Detroit Children's Theatre will close its season with "Young Abe Lincoln," a lively chapter of American history set to music, with performances at 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. May 25.

Fast-moving scenes, a professional cast and nine appealing songs in the production catch the tempo of Lincoln's youthful days in backwoods New Salem, Ill., as he splits rails, falls in the grocery business, wrestles Jack Armstrong, courts Ann Rutledge and leads the militia off to fight the Black Hawk Indians.

The book for the musical production was written by Richard N. Bernstein and John Allen. Victor Ziskin supplied the original score and Joan Javits and Arnold Smogard contributed a special dialogue and lyrics.

General admission is \$1.25 (groups of 10 or more, \$1 each). Tickets are at the Detroit Institute of Arts ticket office (832-2780), J.L. Hudson's and Grinnell's. Children under 12 years must be accompanied by an adult.
