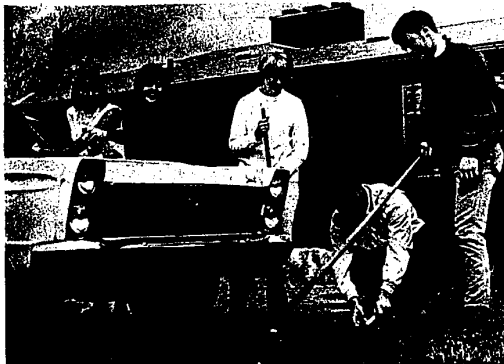

Trash Pickup Set Saturday In North End

Farmington Township is due to complete its special spring rubbish cleanup program Saturday, May 18, but it may take more than the one day to do it. The area included in this final phase extends from 11 to 14 Mile Rds. for the entire width of the township. Householders have been advised that they can put any odds and ends — except garbage at roadside for pickup. A second rule demands that doors be removed from any discarded refrigerators. The final piece of advice is to the effect that if the trash is not collected Saturday, just

leave it at roadside, as ultimately will see that it is slightly as it may be. Trucks removed.
