Witnesses will be present from Livonia, Farmington, Wayne, Westland, Garden City, Redford and Belleville congregations, all part of the Michigan Circuit 45.

The convention theme will be "Holding Strong in the Faith."

Several members of the local congregations will appear on the program. R. DeCarlo will speak Friday evening on the subject "Examine Your Work. Does It Make You Glad?"

Saturday afternoon R.W. Selbert, of Farmington, will address the audience on "Let Anyone Hearing Say 'Come'" based on Revelations 22:17.

The convention's main address will be "Why Does God Permit Wickedness?" by L.E. Reusch, district supervisor of Jehovah's witnesses in this area, on Sunday, June 2.

Reusch, a traveling representative of the Westwater Bible and Tract Society, will join ministers from the Livonia congregation in calling on residents in home missionary service before the convention begins.

Pre-convention activity for the Livonia group also will include showing of a film entitled "God Cannot Lie" at 7 p.m. Wednesday, May 29, in Kingsdom Hall, 4744 Ann Arbor Trail, Reusch will narrate and the public is invited.

The Pioneer Girls of Farmington's First Baptist Church are planning a pot-luck dinner and awards night May 27 at 6:30 p.m. in the church.

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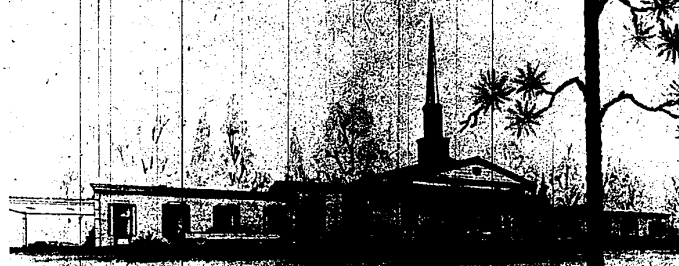

Inner-City 1 Pastor Will Speak

The Rev. David Eberhard, a well-known pastor from Detroit's inner-city will speak in St. Paul's Lutheran Church—Middlebelt at Eight Mile, Farmington, at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday, May 28.

Rev. Eberhard is pastor of the Riverside Lutheran Church on the Lower East Side of Detroit.

In his talk, he will discuss the Christian attitude toward the Negro, especially during riots, whether Christians should bear arms for self-protection during riots and he will also tell what happened in the Riverside parish during the rioting last summer and during the recent crisis.

A question and answer period will follow.

Pastor Eberhard is well-known throughout the country for his leadership in community life and is classified as one of the outstanding civic leaders in America.

He has been acclaimed as responsible for acclaimed as a dynamic parish program, which is a thoroughly committed, organized, and well-planned. The program has been featured in Life Magazine, on the Mike Douglas Show and in July of 1967 CBS presented a national documentary on his work.

This program has been arranged by St. Paul's Women's League and is open to the public.
