

OCC Candidates To Speak May 23

The 13 candidates for the Board of Trustees of Oakland Community College will attend a faculty-sponsored meeting at 2:30 p.m. Thursday, May 23, in the Oakland County Board of Supervisors auditorium, 1200 N. Telegraph Rd., Pontiac.

Purpose of the get-acquainted meeting is to enable the electorates to inform themselves on the issues. Election for the trustees will be held June 10.

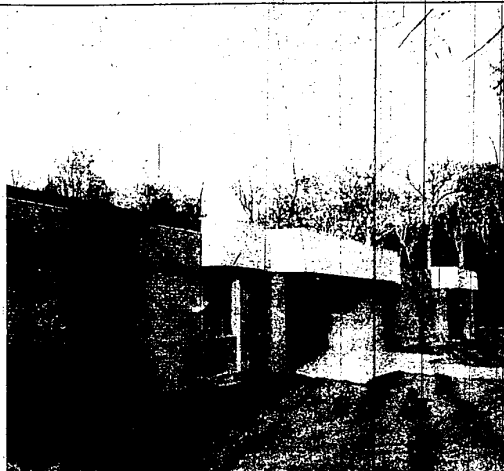
To be elected are three trustees for six-year terms. One new position has been added so that the board of trustees will consist of seven members instead of the present six.

Five of the 13 seeking elec-

tion are from Farmington: Douglas J. Collins, 38415 Grand River; Robert M. Colyer, 22905 Hayden; Bernard S. Kahn, 22945 Sugar Spring; Mrs. Sandra G. Landman, 34316 Thornbrook Dr.; and Richard Alan Reynolds, 40020 Minglewood.

Two incumbents on the ballot are David W. Hackett, of Rochester, and Gordon C. Henderson, of Birmingham.

The other candidates are Mrs. Lucien Floyd, of Waterford; Raymond E. Hoffman, of Union Lake; Donald F. Loper, of Pontiac; David M. Preston, of Birmingham; Harold Provizer, of Southfield; and Boyd C. Zacharias, of Birmingham.

Vagnozzi To Seek Ray Baker's Seat

Aldo Vagnozzi of Farmington Township has announced his candidacy for state representative.

The district includes the cities of Farmington, Keego Harbor, Lathrup Village, Orchard Lake Village and part of Southfield and the townships of Farmington and West Bloomfield.

Incumbent Republican Raymond L. Baker has already announced that he is a candidate for re-election.

Vagnozzi will run on the Democratic ticket.

A GRADUATE of Wayne State University, Vagnozzi is currently editor of the Michigan AFL-CIO News.

Born in Roseto, Italy, Vagnozzi immigrated to the United States when he was seven. His fluent Italian served him well during World War II when he served as an interpreter.

His recent activities involved both community and political projects.

Community projects include: former president of the Beechview PTA; founding president of the Beechview PTA; member of the Greater Farmington Youth Guidance Committee as well as Boy Scout and Little League committees.

Vagnozzi is chairman of the 19th Congressional District Democratic Organization, treasurer of the Oakland County Democratic Committee, former president of the Farmington Democratic Club and twice the nominee for Farmington Township Supervisor.

He was an alternate delegate to the 1966 Democratic national

convention.

VAGNOZZI said that he would carry on a vigorous campaign based on the issues. In his job he spends considerable time keeping in touch with and reporting the activities of the Michigan legislature.

"My main concern is in the area of education and the failure of the present Legislature to adequately finance area schools resulting in millage issues to raise local property taxes," Vagnozzi said.

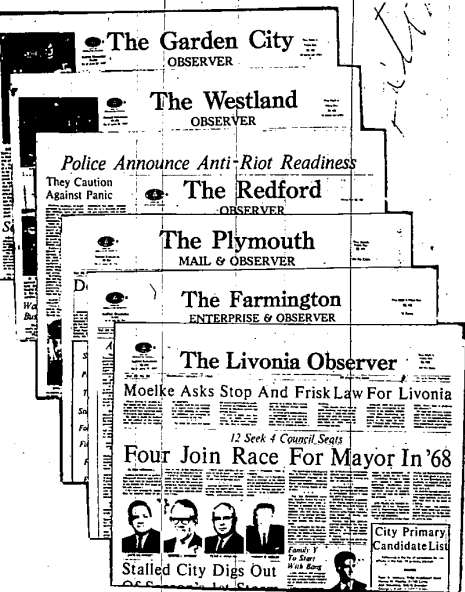
