## NLRB Orders Reinstatement Of Bricklayer

The National Labor Relations Board has ordered the J.A. Ferguson Construction Co., 32715 Folsom Rd., Farmington, to reinstate with full back pay an employee discharged last Aug. 17.

The employee, Eugene Tolot, a bricklayer, charged that he was a victim of discrimination because of union activities.

Trial Examiner Sidney Sherman of the N.L.R.B. conducted hearings and stated in his findings that he supported Tolot's claim. Company officials declined to make any public statement on the matter.
