Pesticides Kill Helpful Bees

Manytpesticios can be just as toute to honey bees and other beneficial insects as they are to harmful insects.

Since honey bees play a major role in pollinating Michagan crops valued at more than \$80 million annually, it is necessary we do our utmost to safeguard them from hazardous sprays and dusts, says Dr. Bert Martin, Michigan State University entomologist.

To avoid contamination, he suggests that pesticides not be applied during periods of plant bloom. Treatment when bees are foraging in the field may also be dangerous because of wind dirth. Bees sometimes forage as far as two miles from the colony, so betweepers in the vicinity should smaller the suggestion of the colony, so betweepers in the vicinity should safe he mends.

An additional requirement for success is ample moisture. Water the trees during dry spells and give the trees a thorough soaking in fall before freezing weather arrives.

The Korean dogwood (Cornus Kousa), or Chinese dogwood, as it is also called, blooms in June and has large white flowers that remain on the shrub or tree for about four weeks. It is a handsome and hardy plant that deserves wider recognition.

OTHER MEMBERS of the dogwood family include the well-known red-osier or red stem dogwood. This is a hardy shrub that is beloved because of the beauty of the lacquerred stems when seen against snow in winter. There is also a yellow-stemmed variety. In addition to these horti-cultural varieties, there are quite a few shrubby, dogwoods that grow wild in the area. These often grow into dense thickets. Included are round-leaved

thickets.
Included are round-leaved dogwood, alternate-leaved dogwood, panicled dogwood, gray dogwood, and a tiny woodland plant called bunchberry.

Droughts Wilt Trees

If some of your shade trees were in poor health this spring

were in poor health this spring without any apparent cause, it could be the result of long periods of drought last summer and caused leaf witting on some of your trees last summer and possibly, premature autumn coloration and early leaf drop, but, primarily, drought causes death of small, feeder roots, and signs of such injury seldom are noticeable until the following spring.


