### Terry Towelling Makes Nice Bibs

Bibs of terry toweling make nice gifts for the new baby. If you are not an old hand at cutting out a pattern for the bib, place an oblong china platter upside down on wrapping paper, mark around with a pencil and use this as your pattern.

Then cut out the neck hole about 2 1/2 linches from one end, Cut an opening through the back cutting a straight linch. Finish by binding with bias tape, leaving the tape extending on each side of the back of the neck for tying.
