Nissokone Sets Camp Schedule

The Metropolitan Detroit YMCA Camp Nissokone is currently taking registrations for boys between the ages of 9 and 18 for the summer periods. Nissokone is located 180 miles north of Detroit on 650 acres of land surrounding Lake Van Etan near Oscoda.

Junior campers, age 9-11, and senior campers, 12-16, spend three weeks exploring the area and the world about them through such activities as swimming, horseback riding, arts and crafts, canoeing, sailing, drama, tennis, riflery, archery and water skiing.

NISSOKONE also operates two special groups, the Canadian Trailblazers and the Michigan Bike Hikers. The Canadian Trailblazers spend 12 days on wilderness wa-

ters working and living together. A five day pre-training program at Camp Nissokone teaches the young men how to canoe, build fires, cook and be proficient in other woodcraft skills.

Scholars Gain Oakland Honor

Two Farmington students at Oakland University were among 77 who earned special winter term academic honors by being named as "University Scholars," the highest of three Dean's List categories.

Such recognition requires a grade point average of at least 3.0, with no grade below 3.0. Farmington students in that category were Clark Hunter, of 29610 Gilchrist, and Bonnie Foyle, of 35483 Lytle.

There is a three-day rest period in camp after the trip. Boys 14 and up with previous camp experience may join this unit. The Michigan Bike Unit's program has three, five and 12 day trips.

ANOTHER Nissokone activity is the Counselor-in-Training program open to young men who have finished the 10th grade. The boys study the fundamentals of camping with an experienced camp leader and provide general assistance to the camp's program staff.
