## Proposed Seminar Will Study Youth Problems

Farmington school children have taken home questionnaires designed to measure parental interest in a proposed Fall Seminar Series on the problems of children growing up in today's world.

The seminar, contemplated by the Farmington Youth Guidance Committee, would be held one evening a week for four weeks in those schools where sufficient interest is expressed. Parents are being asked to select the discussion topics for the four seminars. Each program would have qualified speakers followed by small discussion groups. Subjects may vary considerably from school to school. If parents from different parts of Farmington have different concerns about their children.

The theme for the seminar is "Problems of Normal Children Today." The range of topics parents may pick from includes: children's responsibilities; their social groups; school; moral standards; individual development; youth and the law; family relationships; job preparation; and religion. Parents interested in the series are urged by Youth Guidance Committee members to complete the unsigned question-

naire and return it immediately so plans may be completed before school starts in September.
