

New Cakes Provide Baking Fun

Cake baking can be fun if you know all about cakes. Be familiar with both kinds of cakes, shortened and unshortened, and be successful each time you bake.

A shortened cake can be any of these: butter, fruit cakes, chiffon cakes or pound cakes. When followed closely, these basic steps will give you a perfect cake.

1-Follow the recipe closely. Never make changes in amounts of ingredients.

2-Check to see that you have the correct cake pans as called for in the recipe.

3-Fill cake pans one-half to two-thirds full.

4-Bake in preheated oven.

5-Space oven racks so cake will be as near the center of the oven as possible.

6-Check for doneness only at the end of baking time. Do not peek at the cake during baking.

7-Be sure cake is thoroughly cooled before frosting.

IT'S IMPORTANT THAT you use the correct method for mixing the cake. Several methods are used but the most common ones are: miffin, creaming, quick-mix and chiffon. The method used to mix a cake is determined by the kind of cake being made. Each method will produce a cake with a different texture. There are many different kinds of cakes to try. If you've never made a cake using jello as an ingredient, you might like to try the strawberry cake. The children would probably enjoy the quick fudge cake.

ORANGE CAKE

2 c. pecans
1 lb. orange candy slices
1 box dates
1 c. coconut
1 1/2 c. sugar
1 c. butter melted
1/2 c. buttermilk
1 soda
2 c. soda

Mix pecans, candy, dates, coconut, sugar and butter well. Add buttermilk and blend well. Blend soda into flour by sifting together; add to sugar mixture in small amounts. Bake in a large tube pan at 300 degrees for 1 hour.

ICING:

1 stick margarine
1 box confectioners' sugar
1 8-oz pkg. cream cheese
1 T. orange flavoring

Melt butter; blend in other ingredients. Ice cake when cool. Yield 10 servings.

QUICK FUDGE CAKE

1 pkg. chocolate pudding and pie filling mix
1 pkg. Devil's Food cake mix
1/2 c. chopped walnut meats
1/2 c. semisweet chocolate pieces

Grease and flour 13 x 9 1/2 x 2-inch pan. Set oven temperature at 350 degrees. Prepare pudding mix according to package directions. Blend dry cake mix into hot pudding. Pour mixture into prepared pan. Sprinkle with nuts and chocolate bits. Bake 30 to 45 minutes. Serve with whipped cream if desired. Other nuts may be substituted for walnuts.

STRAWBERRY CAKE

1 box white cake mix
1 box strawberry jello
1 c. salad oil
1/2 c. water
4 eggs
1 box frozen strawberries, thawed
1 box powdered sugar
1/2 c. margarine

Reserve 1/2 c. strawberry juice for icing. Mix first six ingredients until well blended. Bake in three layer pans at 350 degrees for 30 to 35 minutes; cool. Frost cake with mixture of powdered sugar, margarine and reserve strawberry juice. Yield: 16-20 servings.

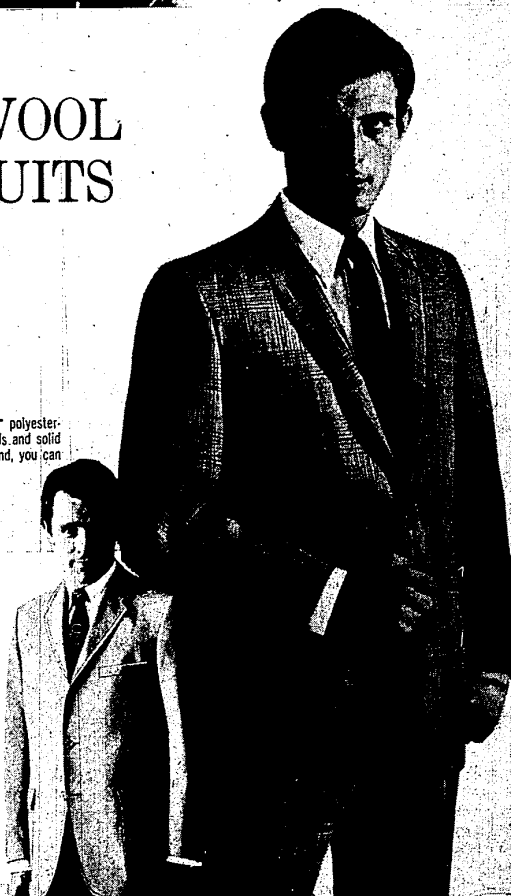
