





Carpet Scraps Clean Screens

Spring is the time when home-owners taken out their screens, clean off the wire, and coat them if necessary to prevent

Scrap pieces of carpet are excellent for this job, Nail to blocks of wood for easy harding. Use one piece to dust the wire, another to apply screen enamel or varnish to the wire mesh. Discard each one as it gets dirty or worn.

Varnish Protects

Stains color wood but do not always offer adequate protec-tion from wear, foods and liq-uids. After staining wood fur-niture or paneling, coat the surface with varnish or lacquer. You'll need at least two coats to make the gloss uniform.
