## Six Area Churches Get Pulpit Changes

Six United Methodist churches in the area will see pulpits changed as a result of changes in pastoral appointments announced by Bishop Dwight E. Loder during the recent annual conference at Adrian College.

Two of the new ministers are coming to the Plymouth area, with the Rev. Paul M. Cargo coming from Caro to be minister of the First United Methodist Church of Plymouth and the Rev. Erand L. O'Leary, of Keweenaw, taking over at St. Luke's Methodist in Plymouth Township.

The Rev. Herbert C. Brubaker is leaving the Plymouth Church to be associate minister at the First United Methodist Church of Midland, and the Rev. George W. Vandenbosch, of St. Luke's, will go to Burton United Methodist Church in Flint.

THE REV. PAUL HART will come from Trinity Methodist in Flint to fill the pulpit at St. Matthew's Livonia. His associate minister will be the Rev. Haldon Ferris, who comes from an Evangelical United Brethren Church in the Niles area. The Methodist and EUB churches have joined to form the United Methodist Church.
